

## **Soil & Soil Aid Descriptions**

**COMPOST** - A rich composted dairy manure, this MUST be mixed into existing soil at a rate of no more than 2" compost to 6" of existing soil. This composted manure adds nutrient value to the soil; however, caution must be taken to not mix it too strong as it can "burn" plants if it is applied incorrectly.

**TOPSOIL** – Topsoil is the upper layer of soil that is often removed during construction projects to preserve it for use in landscaping. Our topsoil is locally sourced and can be improved for planting by adding compost, Soil Pep, or Premium Garden Soil.

**ENRICHED TOPSOIL-** A 50/50 mix of Screened Topsoil and Premium Garden Soil.

**SCREENED TOPSOIL** – Simply put, this is topsoil that has been screened to remove large clods and debris, creating a nice soil for topdressing new lawns and landscape beds.

**PREMIUM GARDEN SOIL** - This premium blend of Composted Bark Fines, Cow Manure and Peat Moss is best blended 50/50 with your existing soil. Premium Garden Soil conditions clay soil by adding organic matter to enrich the soil, increase moisture levels and improve nutrient retention. An excellent additive to any soil that will be planted whether it be trees, shrubs, edible garden, lawn, or flowers.

**RAISED GARDEN MIX** – A unique blend of peat moss, organic bark soil, coco coir compost & perlite, coming straight from nature. This blend allows drainage in the confines of a raised box or container and is light enough to encourage excellent root growth and breathability. Excellent choice for raised gardens, containers, rooftop gardens and greenhouses.

**SOIL PEP** – A partially decomposed bark product that can be used as either a soil additive to enrich the existing soil or as a decorative mulch. As a mulch it will help prevent weeds, retain moisture, and should be used without weed fabric so that it will enrich the soil over time.
